# SFSU Involvement

San Francisco State University (SFSU) is an active partner in the California Community College's Electronic Transcript Exchange Project (CCCTran). This very ambitious project began with:

# SFSU Involvement (cont)

- ❖ The California Community Colleges (CCC) looking for a better way to exchange transcripts with each other
- ❖ The beta project to include a few California State University campuses (CSU).
- ❖ XAP was chosen as a vendor and began developing a web site that has a number of very useful features that go beyond transcript exchange

# Development Goals of CCCTran

- ❖ Multiple delivery methods
- ❖ Tracking capabilities
- ❖ Automatic emails
- ❖ User defined reports
- ❖ Translating XML into EDI and send EDI through UT Austin's Server, which is a big plus for SF State and other CSUs.
- ❖ Institutions that are not part of CCCTran can send EDI or XML Postsecondary Transcripts to CCCTran participants via the UT Austin's Server (EDI has been tested and works, XML has not yet been tested).

# California Community Colleges

The CCC project team consists of Information Technology and Admissions & Records representatives from each of seven pilot colleges, CCC Chancellor's Office staff, and XAP representatives.

# Current Development

- CCTran finished Beta Testing in July 2007 with it's pilot colleges and is going live with three of it's four pilots (Santa Rosa Junior College, Cypress and Sacramento City College).
- SF State is looking forward to being able to order and receive transcripts through CCTran starting in Fall 2007.
